

MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERVISOR




Dear Resident:

Congratulations. Thanks to you, Islip Town remains a leader in protecting the environment. In fact, Islip was just awarded an "A" for our recycling program by the Citizens Campaign for the Environment – the only "A" awarded to any town on Long Island. Our award-winning recycling program is designed to meet your recycling needs and contribute positively toward the goal of a greener, healthier planet. Our Stop Throwing Out Pollutants (S.T.O.P.) program not only helps in preventing harmful pollutants from entering the waste stream, but helps rid households of unwanted, and possibly toxic, materials.

As a resident of the Town of Islip, you can take advantage of the upcoming S.T.O.P. Day, Saturday, September 13, 2008, between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m., by bringing your pollutants to the Multi-Purpose Recycling Facility (MRF) on Lincoln Avenue, in Holbrook. Our trained staff can dispose of them properly. Bring items such as automotive fluids, empty propane tanks, paint removers and pesticides. In addition, you can safely dispose of e-waste, such as computers, printers, and electronic games and gadgets. Inside this handy flyer, you will find a complete list of S.T.O.P. pollutants that will be accepted.

Please take the time to review what items will be accepted at the recycling facility. Remember that the Town of Islip S.T.O.P. program is limited to residents, so bring proof of residency when you visit the facility.

On behalf of the Islip Town Board, I thank you for your participation in the S.T.O.P. program, as well as your participation in all our recycling programs. Your active participation guarantees the continued success of our Town recycling efforts.

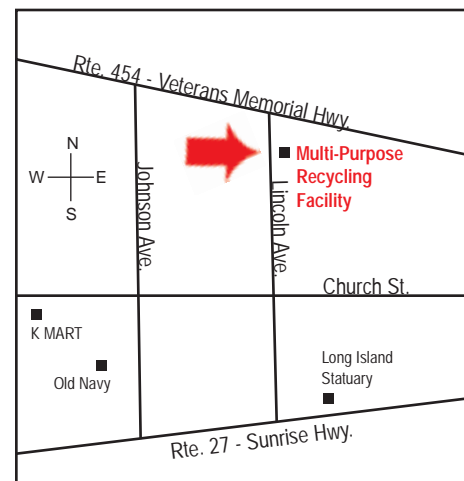
PROGRAM—Stop Throwing Out Pollutants!

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

For Town of Islip residents, proof of residency will be required. Waste from commercial establishments will not be accepted.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- Bring products in the original labeled container only.
- Each container should be individually placed in a clear plastic bag and sealed.
- Double bagging or adding absorbent material is recommended.
- Extra caution is needed for leaking containers.
- For safe transport, pack sealed containers with newspapers and place in a secure box.
- Quantities will be limited to five gallons or ten pounds, and three empty propane tanks per household.
- Complete and bring the attached form with you.

- Aerosol Cans
- Air-Conditioning Refrigerants
- Antifreeze
- Automotive Fluids
- Bug and Rodent Killers
- Chemistry Kits
- Drain Cleaners
- Deodorizers
- Driveway Sealant
- E-Waste (computers, monitors, printers, electronic games, etc.)
- Fertilizers with Herbicides
- Fluorescent Bulbs
- Gasoline (containers must be left at site)
- Household Batteries
- Laundry Products
- Medicines and Medicinal Ointments
- Non-Latex Paints (oil-based)
- Oven Cleaners
- Paint Thinner



- Pet Cleaners
- Photographic Chemicals
- Polish and Wood Preservatives
- Pool Chemicals
- **Propane Tanks (empty) 20 lbs.**
- Rug and Upholstery Cleaners
- Spot Removers and Other Solvents
- Thermometers
- Thermostats
- Unused Flammable Liquids
- Used Motor Oil (containers must be left at site)
- Weed Killers

The Following Types of Products Will NOT Be Accepted:

- Ammunition
- Explosives & Fireworks & Flares
- Fire Extinguishers
- Radioactive Materials
- Unlabeled Materials
- Smoke Detectors
